STUDENT FEES: Invoices for student fees will be mailed home in mid-September and all fees are due on September 30, 2019. Payment can be made online through the PowerSchool Parent Portal or at the school office from 8:15 am - 3:30 pm. All students will be invoiced for the following fees:

Student Fee - \$11.00

Course Fees (Most optional courses have a fee and are listed in detail online through the PowerSchool Parent Portal and on our school website).

YEARBOOKS: Students are encouraged to pre-order yearbooks, available at a cost of \$52.50.

**LOCKERS:** Lockers, complete with a school combination padlock, will be assigned to all students on the first day provided a Locker License Agreement was completed at registration time and signed by the student and parent/guardian. There is no charge for lockers, unless a lock is damaged or lost (\$6.00).

**GRAD FEE:** All Grade 12 students are required to pay the graduation fee. This will appear on their student fees. Our graduation will take place on **Friday, June 12, 2020** at the Edmonton Expo Centre.

SCHOOL COUNCIL: First meeting is on *Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at 7:00 pm*. in the Library Union Café. All parents are encouraged to become involved in the School Council. *Education is a partnership - let's make it work to benefit our students!*

**DLR (Directed Learning Room):** When students choose not to make the most of their class and Seminar time, they fall behind. Teachers and Grade Coordinators may choose to nominate individuals for DLR in order to catch up. DLR is hosted Mondays through Thursdays from 3:00 until 5:00 pm and is supervised by an Administrator. It is our belief that students can be responsible for their learning by making the most of Seminar and PLT; however, when they fail to do so, we hold them accountable with DLR. We don't want learning to fall through the cracks.

**PLT (Personalized Learning Time):** Seven days throughout the school year, students will have access to approximately two hours of self-directed time. Similar to seminar, students will have access to their teachers for extra support or be able to work with their peers or collaborative projects. **As with seminar, attendance is expected.** 

**SEMINAR:** Seminar time occurs Monday - Friday from 2:25 – 3:07 pm. Students are to be using this time wisely as it is **expected** that students are in attendance until 3:07 pm.

TCT (Teacher Collaborative Time): Nine times throughout the year, <u>classes start at 9:54 am.</u> This provides staff the opportunity to meet with each other to improve their practice. For bussed students, there are areas for them to work in until classes begin at 10:00 am.
