Spruce Grove Composite High School Drive In Graduation Ceremony June 11, 2021 at 4:30 pm (gates open at 3:00 pm) Edmonton Expo Centre

Class of 2021, Parents/Guardians:

Your graduation day is almost here. We must ensure the regulations provided by AHS are followed to keep everyone safe. All guests must remain in their vehicles at all times except to use the washroom. Vehicles will be spaced apart by parking attendants on site. No standing or sitting outside your vehicle is permitted. Limos, party buses, RVs, tailgating, etc are not permitted. Attendees can only share vehicles with members of their household.

For those of you attending the graduation ceremony, there are large screens placed throughout the parking lot for easy viewing as graduates cross the stage. Speeches and entertainment will have been pre-recorded and the entire event will be transmitted through a FM frequency into your vehicle. We estimate the event will take approximately two hours. After the ceremony, Edmonton Expo will open the exit gates. Encore will be professionally live streaming and recording the event for non attending family and friends to enjoy. We will send an update and the live streaming link to all students, parents and guardians the week of June 7, 2021.

DISPLAY YOUR PARKING PERMIT ON YOUR DASHBOARD as this is proof of your payment and required for you to enter the lot.

The gates will open at 3:00 pm and the ceremony begins at 4:30 pm. Staff will be assisting graduates to line up according to AHS protocol that day, and **cross the stage wearing a mask**. Once they exit the stage, Lifetouch will be taking a picture of each student with their certificate in a separate staging area and graduates can remove their mask for this picture.
