All student timetables are currently viewable through their parent/guardian's PowerSchool Portal. Direct student access through PowerSchool will be enabled once students receive their login and password on Tuesday, August 30th. All timetable change requests must be made in this fashion and are reviewed in the order that they are received. The school office will open on August 22 at noon.

There are no supply lists for high school students. Most students organize themselves with binders and looseleaf.

LOCKERS: Every Grade 10 student will be assigned a locker. Students are expected to use lockers in the morning, at lunch and after school only and store only essential school and Physical Education items. There is no charge for lockers, unless a lock is damaged or lost (\$6.00)

**NO GRADE 10 PARKING:** Due to the shortage of parking spaces, only grade 11 and 12 students are able to park in the student parking area.

SCHOOL PICTURES: School pictures will be taken Tuesday, August 30 and students will be given their Comp Card. Lifetouch will also give students their unique code to order school pictures on that day.

YEARBOOKS: Students are encouraged to pre-order yearbooks, available at a cost of \$52.50.

## MATH:

**Math 10C** students will require an **approved** graphing calculator. We recommend one of the following calculators:

- TI-83 Plus
- TI-84 Plus
- TI-84 Plus Silver
- TI-84 CE

**Math 10-3** students will require a scientific calculator (preferably with a 2-line display). These may be purchased from the school for \$15.
