- ❖ You need
 - Alberta Student Number (ASN) - found at the bottom of Comp Card
 - a **personal** email address
- ❖ Enter your **PERSONAL** email address and select “I’m new. Sign me up”
- ❖ You will receive an email with a confirmation link
- ❖ Click on the link provided and enter a screen name and password. Enter ASN, DOB and indicate you are the student on the following page. Click Activate.
- ❖ 3rd Parties (IE. Guardians) can go through a similar process to the above to view their student’s Ed Info

Before You Start

The ApplyAlberta system will allow you to create a profile with your personal information and academic history. This information is filled in automatically on your application(s) to Alberta post-secondary institutions.

You will need the following:

1. A **MyAlberta Digital ID**. You will be prompted to create a MyAlberta Digital ID if you do not already have one. If you have previously used ApplyAlberta, you will need to transfer your former SIAMS account to your MyAlberta Digital ID - the system will walk you through the account transfer process.
2. Your **Alberta Student Number (ASN)**. If you have applied to or attended a school or post-secondary institution in Alberta, you will already have an ASN. To find your ASN, you can use the [ASN Lookup](#) service. If you do not have an ASN, the ApplyAlberta system will assign one to you.
3. Names of **all high schools and post-secondary institutions you have attended or are currently attending**.
4. **High school courses and marks** (for currently enrolled Canadian students only).
5. A **credit card will be necessary** to pay any application fees charged by the institution(s).



- ❖ Your application is not complete until you have completed a portal page and submitted your marks .
- ❖ Proof of Enrollment - what is this?

- ❖ If you are being asked for a proof of enrollment document or progress report, you can download an SGCHS timetable and your progress report from Powerschool, and then update these documents on your portal page. *Stop by Student Services to have it officially school stamped.
- ❖ It is your responsibility to continually check your application status and to-do list.

 - Attendance in good standing

GRAD LIST:

- ✓ Grad Lists will be posted throughout the year
- ✓ Students can shift on and off of each Grad List, depending on their progress, achievement, etc.
- ✓ Expect Grad Lists to be posted:
 - End of Sept / Early October
 - Mid to Late November, after Mid-term Reports
 - February (post Semester 1 & inclusive of Diploma Marks)
 - 2nd Semester - Lists become more frequent
- ✓ Email communication will occur with each Grad List posting
