Students complete an English course in both Semesters of Grade 10 year and receive 10 credits upon completion.

*Math 15 Prep is a course designed to help students who envision themselves taking an academic stream of Math, but may have some gaps in understanding or skill. Students Grade 9 mark may not meet the requirement to enter directly to Math 10C. This transition course focuses on building skills which will allow them to be successful in Math 10C, or Math 10-3 in Semester 2 of their Grade 10 year and receive 10 credits upon completion.
